# Valid Application

- ▶ You need a pass in English Lang, Maltese, Maths and a Science subject
- ▶ A minimum of 6 Ordinary level results not including ECDL
- ▶ Minimum of Grade 3 to choose subject at A level
- ▶ Minimum of Grade 5 to choose subject at IM level
- ▶ English Lang A level also requires a pass in Literature
- ▶ Physics and Maths at Intermediate Level also require Grade 3 at SEC (or Grade B)
- ▶ ECDL is equivalent to Grade 3, however IT Intermediate is worked out on average.





- ▶ For Applied Mathematics, Art, Economics, Engineering Drawing, Environmental Science, Geography, History, Home Economics, Information Technology, Marketing, Philosophy, Physical Education, Psychology, Religion, Sociology, and Theatre & Performance at Intermediate Level, no 'O' level passes are required.
- ▶ For Art, Geography, History, Home Economics, Marketing, Philosophy, Religion and Sociology at Advanced Level, no 'O' level passes are required.
- ▶ A pass in ECDL (core/advanced) will be considered at a Grade 3 (SEC equivalent).



# Logistical details

- ▶ Lessons start at 7.45 till 3.30
- ▶ Two 30-minutes breaks
- ▶ Lessons are 45 minutes long
- ▶ Weekly sports session
- ▶ Optional daily mass at 7.15
- ▶ Weekly mass on Friday at 9.15
- ▶ No uniform – dress smartly.
- ▶ Personal Development Programme and Social Responsibility Programme.

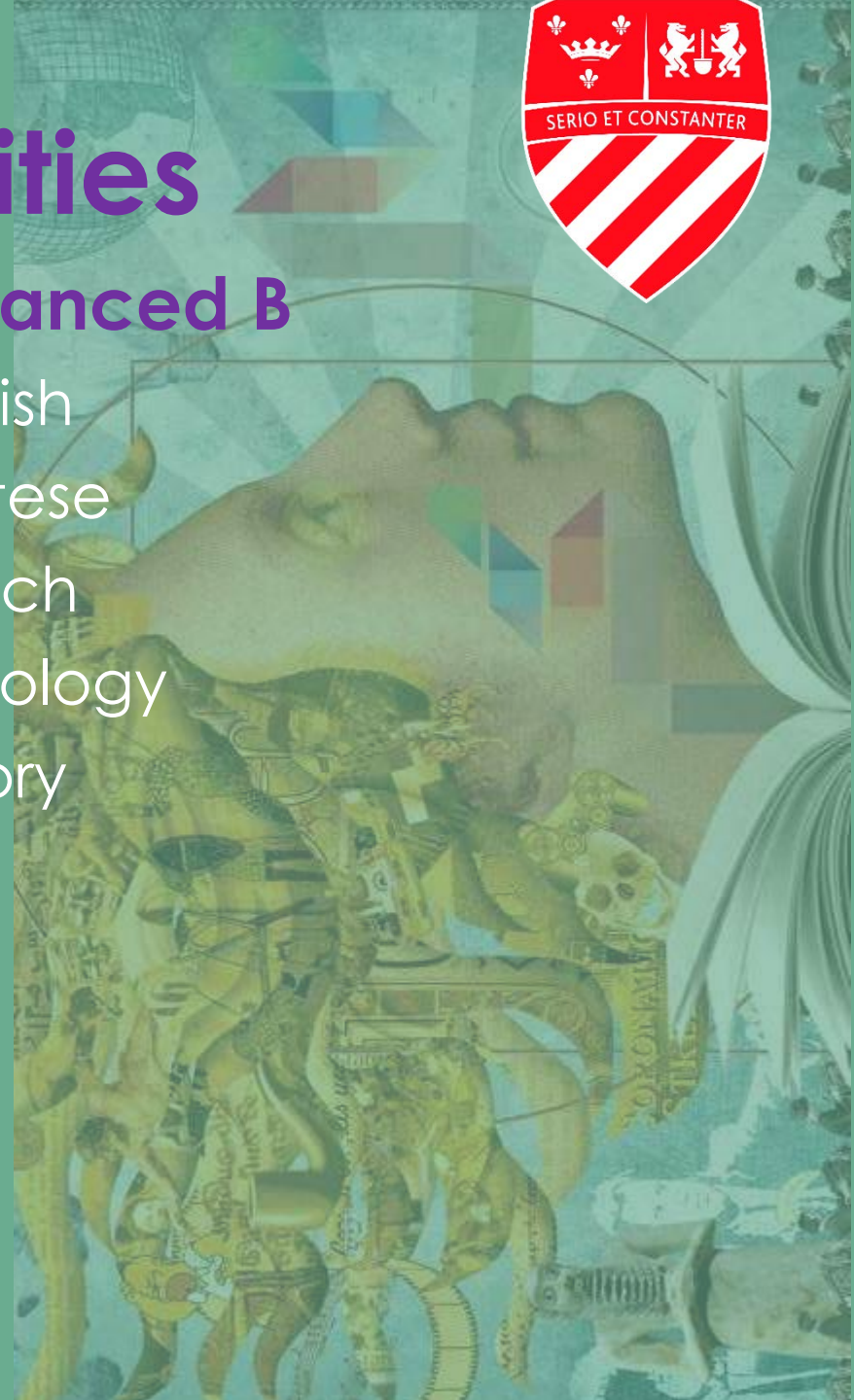

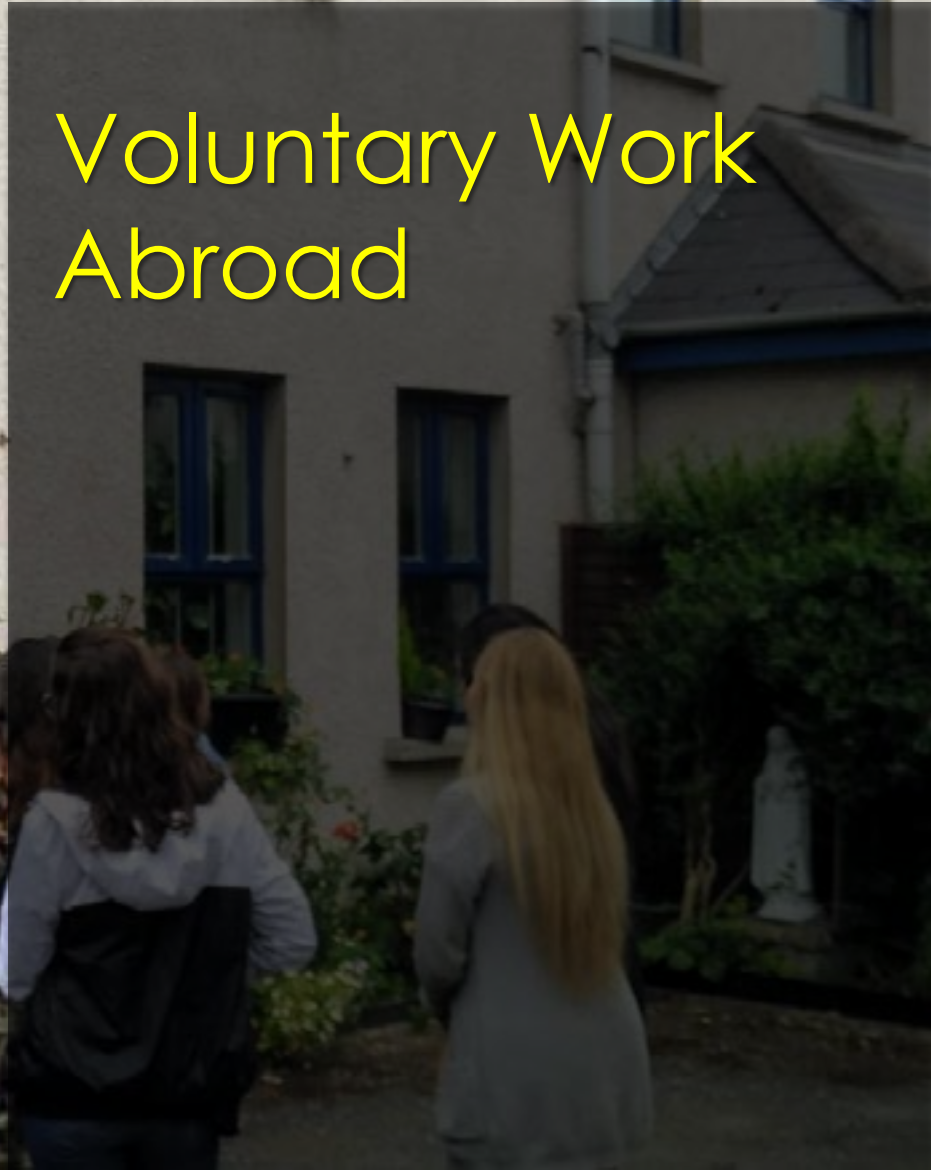
