

## HOW TO READ THE RANK ORDER

1. The rank order published is for all applicants into St Aloysius College Sixth Form for 2022.
2. The list is presented in reference number sequence **and not according to course.**
3. Therefore a student may be accepted for a course with, for example 155 points, but be on the waiting list of another course with 155 points.
4. The waiting list is also published according to course. The waiting list (WL) number indicates the applicant's place on the waiting list of the course/subjects combination chosen.
5. **Therefore, waiting list places according to number of points may vary between courses, for example, a student may be on waiting list number 10 for one course with 155 points but be on waiting list number 20 for another course with 155 points.**

## ACCEPTED APPLICANTS

1. Applicants who have been accepted must confirm their place by **Friday 02 September 2022 at 09.00 on the following link:**

2. Applicants who have been accepted and decide not to accept their place, are asked to call 2279 3357/8 or email [headsixthform@staloysius.edu.mt](mailto:headsixthform@staloysius.edu.mt) immediately.
3. Students who confirm their place will be receiving all information regarding the start of school some time during next week. The book list will be uploaded online next week.

### **WAITING LISTS**

1. Students who are on the waiting list will be informed by telephone if they are accepted, should a place in their selected course become vacant. The rank order will be respected. The rank order **will not** be changed online.
2. In cases of a tie on the waiting list between two or more students, the criteria in the section “Selection for Admission” (point 2) in the Sixth Form Prospectus will be adopted, ie.:
  - i. the best grades in the 2 subjects chosen at Advanced level
  - ii. the best grades in the 3 subjects chosen at Intermediate level.

The decision of the Management will be final.
